In Jablonec nad Nisou



A visit to the unique Museum of Glass and Costume Jewellery in Jablonec nad Nisou. Glass processing and jewellery production have had a major impact on the development of our region in the last century. Even today, the production of jewellery plays an important role in the life of our town. In Liberec (it is 12 km away from Jablonec nad Nisou)



Free tour of the North Bohemian Museum in Liberec. It is the oldest museum of arts and crafts in the Czech Republic, housed in an architecturally valuable building built in a historicist style at the end of the 19th century. It is necessary to show your identification tag. https://www.muzeumlb.cz/en

Free visit to the Regional Gallery in Liberec (it is next to the North Bohemian Museum). The gallery is located in an Art Nouveau building of the former town spa built in 1906. It is the most important regional gallery that manages important collections of European art. Tickets will be distributed at registration. https://www.ogl.cz/en/





Not too far from the museum and gallery is also the Technical Museum Liberec, with interesting exhibitions especially in the field of transport, but also local industrial production. Currently there is an exhibition of Leonardo da Vinci's machines. https://www.tmliberec.cz/

In Turnov (it is 25 km away from Jablonec nad Nisou)



Free visit to the Museum of Bohemian Paradise in Turnov. The nearby town of Turnov is not only the centre of the beautiful landscape of Bohemian Paradise, but also the place of processing of the Czech garnet, a unique semi-precious stone that is the decoration of many jewels. It is necessary to show a identification tag. https://www.muzeum-turnov.cz/en/

A discount on admission to the state castle Sychrov is provided. It is on the road from Jablonec nad Nisou to Turnov with a small detour. The discount can be applied for by presenting an identification tag. https://www.zamek-sychrov.cz/en
